Specific aims :

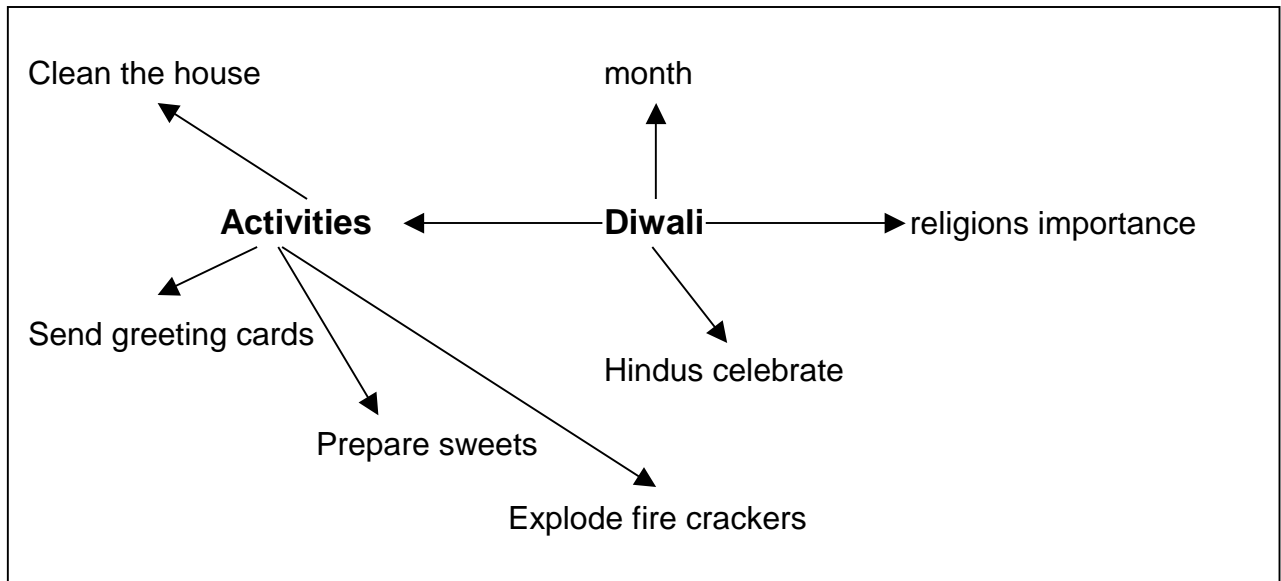
To make them write independently at home with the help of the points given for composition.
