Specific aims :

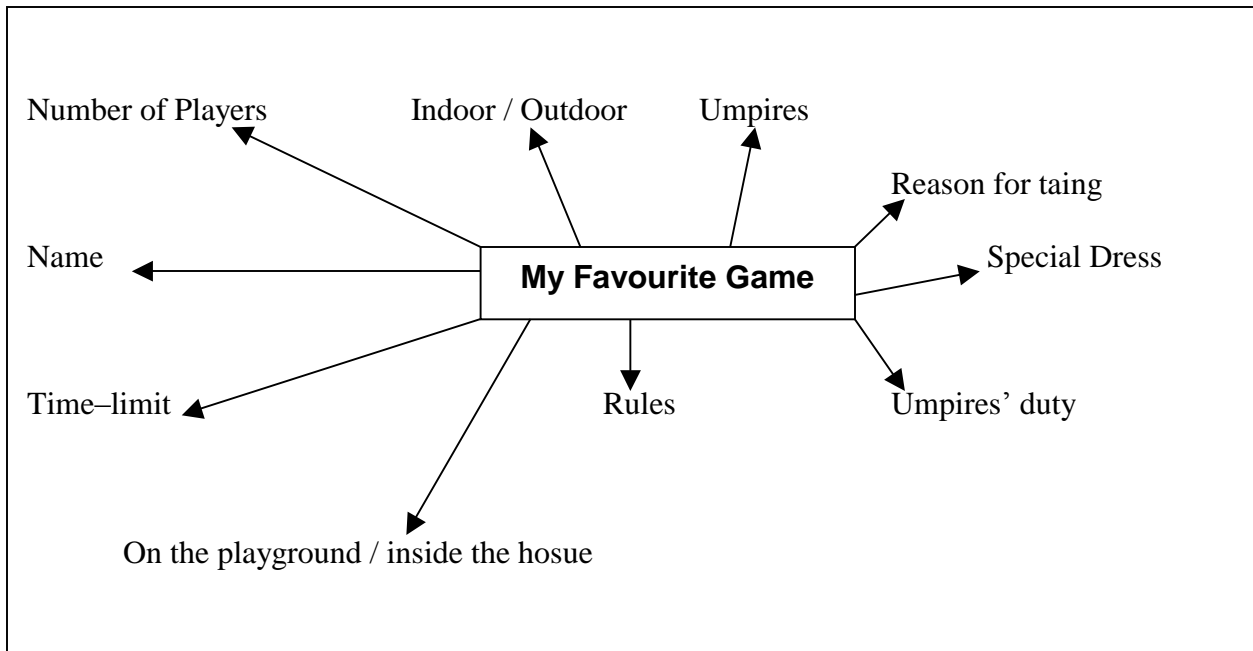
To help them the pupils to develop a paragraph orally followed by writing.
